#### Mrs. Johnson's K4:

**Jan 4-8:** Memory Verse Luke 11:28 "Blessed are they that hear the word of God and keep it." Chapel lessons: Jesus' boyhood, ministry of John the Baptist and Call of the disciples.

Character Development: Truthfulness

Health and Safety: importance of road signs

Language Development: Gardens, groceries, underwater animals

Phonics: letters J, K

K & C say the same sound but k goes with i and e; c

Lots of learning games to review letters A-F and numbers 1-15.

#### Jan 11-15:

Memory verse and Bible lessons same as K4.

Language Development: all about the letter H.

Writing: Tracing the letter H

Lots of learning games and crafts to reinforce the letter H.

goes with the other three, a, o, and u.

Blend Ladders for all consonants learned thus far and the letter J

Handwriting: Upper and lower case J and K

Numbers: 1-11, counting 1-30 and Days of the week.

For **Jan 11-15**, the memory verse is the same.

Chapel lessons: A lame man healed, and The woman at the well

Character Development: Be attentive

Health and Safety: Obey playground rules

Language Development: Games, healthy body and veggies.

Phonics: the letter V. Reading one vowel words the sight word "the" ('thu') and reading the first 2 sentences!
